FinAl Project: Round 2

From October 4-12 Hillside students Apryl Ambas, Brooklyn Dreyer, Sydney Rogers, Madeleine Hatch, Sameeha Fathima, and Brooke Kobe visited Finland with Principal Wood, Mrs. Newman, and Mrs. M. Caron to explore the idea of "What Makes School Great for All?". This trip represented the beginning of Year 2 of the collaborative project between the Alberta Teachers Association and the national board of education in Finland.

Students and teachers learned more about how the education system in Finland differs from Alberta, and while there, collaborated with Finnish students to discuss and present ideas on what they thought were the most positive aspects of the others' school system that they could potentially look at for their own schools. Students were billeted in host families to experience Finnish culture, and in addition to spending time at the Phitipudian Lukio (Pithipudas high school), they also visited a local sawmill (a major industry in Finland), and got to spend some time exploring the culture and history of Helsinki.

The six students who visited Hillside will continue the project over the upcoming months, consulting and collaborating with Hillside students to develop ideas on how to make school great for all. In the spring, Hillside and the surrounding community will once again play host to a number of students and teachers from Pithipudas to continue the project.













Ecuador
